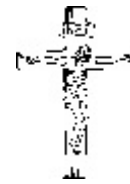
Maundy Thursday



"the same night in which He was betrayed" (I Cor. 11:23)

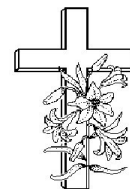
